#### POSITION AT KENORA MIDWIVES

After two years of working in Northwestern Ontario, Kelly is leaving and moving closer to home and her extended family. We will therefore have a position available for a second registered midwife effective August/September 2010.

Kenora Midwives is a busy teaching rural/remote practice serving Kenora and the surrounding area with a growing demand for care from women in the outlying communities. We currently have privileges at Lake of the Woods District Hospital and have a good working relationship with the hospital and nurses. We work with full scope of practice, epidurals are not available for vaginal births and we do not need to transfer care for our inductions. There are no obstetricians in Kenora so we work closely with six family doctors and refer clients to obstetricians in Winnipeg Manitoba when required.

We are currently working as primary care midwives with several prenatal visits with the second midwife. Our clients are aware we now take every second weekend off call (Friday evening until Tuesday morning) and they could have the second midwife at their birth. We can each take more than 40 births /year if desired. We schedule at least one month vacation/year and at least one two week block. The practice has a TAPA in place with the labour and delivery nurses usually attending hospital births as our seconds. Several nurses are on call for home births as well to facilitate our weekends off call. Our office is located in an old house close to the downtown area with each midwife having their own office. We have excellent office staff and the work environment is very comfortable.

For the outdoor enthusiast, our community lies within the heart of Central Canada's largest resort area. This area offers cross country and downhill skiing, fishing, hunting, hiking, skating, snowmobiling, cycling and boating. We are located 222km. north of the Canada/USA border, 200km. east of Winnipeg and 560 km. west of Thunder Bay Ontario on beautiful Lake of the Woods.
