

MIDWIFERY CARE OF PEEL & HALTON HILLS

REGISTERED MIDWIVES

Midwifery Care of Peel and Halton Hills is seeking a general registrant for a 15 month full time locum position for our Georgetown office to replace a maternity leave beginning June 2012 and ending September 2013. The Locum Midwife would be expected to start with one day of clinic a week from May 7th 2012 with June 4th 2012 being the start of her on call period and September 3rd 2013 being the end. She will have 50 BCC over that time period with 10 weeks of vacation. The Georgetown office catchment area is Brampton, Milton and Halton Hills.

Midwifery Care of Peel and Halton Hills is a large suburban/rural practice with two offices and 15 full time midwives serving Mississauga, Brampton, Milton and Halton Hills. Our practice serves a diversity of clients (both in terms of cultural and socio-economic backgrounds) We provide care in a team based model with teams of two midwives sharing client care and working in a rotating schedule of alternating weeks of clinic (with weekends off) and weeks of on call. The midwives in the practice come from a variety of routes of entry to practice (IMPP, PLEA, MEP and Michener) and from a diverse variety of walks of life. We encourage and support our practice members to pursue outside interests both extracurricularly within midwifery and in their personal lives and with their families and value our off call time as much as the time we spend with our clientele and each other. Our home birth rate ranges between 10 and 20% and our hospital privileges are at William Osler Health Centre's Brampton Civic Hospital Site, Trillium Health Centre, Mississauga and Georgetown Hospital. Midwives at all sites are expected to provide full scope and maintain competence in oxytocin augmentation/induction and maintaining primary care with epidural analgesia. We are a teaching practice for the MEP and regularly have multiple students of varying academic levels placed with us over the course of the year.

The ideal candidate will be a general registrant with experience in providing full scope primary care in hospital and comfort and confidence attending home births. We would expect the successful candidate to be able to relocate within or close to the catchment area for the duration of the locum and would expect them to be available to start on or near the beginning of May 2012.
